How to Use This Pack

1. Choose one card.

Pick a song that fits the moment: movement, clean-up, counting, quiet time, or kindness.



2. Sing slowly.

Use clear actions and repeat favourite songs often. A short song used daily can become a helpful routine.

3. Let children join in their own way.

Clapping, watching, pointing, smiling, humming, tapping, or saying one word all count as participation.

Safety reminders

Always supervise toddlers and preschoolers during music, movement, craft, food, and sensory activities. Keep small bells, beads, loose craft pieces, batteries, magnets, cords, strings, ribbons, broken decorations, and choking hazards away from young children. Clear the floor before dancing.

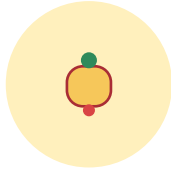

Christmas Song Cards - Set 1



Jingle Bells Movement

**Shake and clap,
stop and go,

Try: Pretend to shake bells, clap the beat, march, tiptoe, then freeze.



We Wish You Singalong

**We wish you a merry Christmas,
we clap and wave today,
kind Christmas wishes
are on the way.**

Try: Wave, clap, tap knees, smile, and sing to family members.



Twinkle Christmas Star

**Twinkle, twinkle, Christmas star,
shining bright from near and far.**

Try: Move a paper star up, down, high, low, and close to your heart.



Reindeer Action Song

**Reindeer, reindeer, tap your feet,
reindeer, reindeer, find the beat.**

Try: Tap feet, clap hands, turn gently, freeze, then sit softly.

Cut out the cards, place them in a basket, or choose one card for each Christmas activity.

Christmas Counting Song

**One little present under the tree,
two little stockings waiting for me.**

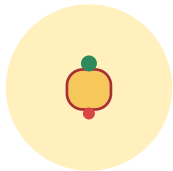
Try: Count safe paper presents, stars, stockings, or baubles from 1 to 5.



Christmas Colour Hunt

**Red, red, what can you see?
A Christmas hat looking back at me.**

Try: Look for red, green, white, gold, and silver items with an adult.



Christmas Clean-Up Song

**Pick it up and put it away,
Christmas helpers save the day.**

Try: Put crayons in a tub, paper in a pile, and safe toys in a basket.



Christmas Kindness Song

**Kind hands, kind words,
kind hearts every day.**

Try: Make a card, say thank you, share a book, or sing for someone.

Cut out the cards, place them in a basket, or choose one card for each Christmas activity.



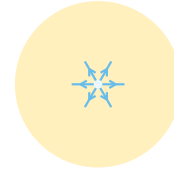
Christmas Song Cards - Set 3



Gentle Nativity Song

**Baby Jesus, gentle light,
love and hope on Christmas night.**

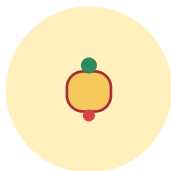
Try: Use a safe picture or colouring page and name the people in the story.



Snowflake Dance Song

**Snowflakes falling soft and slow,
round and round the snowflakes go.**

Try: Float, spin slowly, reach high, crouch low, and rest like snow.



Christmas Drum and Tap

**Tap, tap, tap the Christmas beat,
tap your hands and tap your feet.**

Try: Copy simple rhythms: tap tap, clap clap, slow taps, quiet taps.



Christmas Story Song

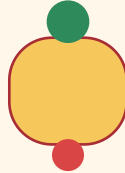
**First we saw a Christmas tree,
then we sang so happily.**

Try: Ask what happened first, next, and last. Make up a tiny song.

Cut out the cards, place them in a basket, or choose one card for each Christmas activity.



Jingle Bells Movement Card



Shake and clap, stop and go,
Christmas bells ring soft and slow.
March around, then freeze today,
Jingle fun in a safe play way.

Actions to try

1. Pretend to shake bells with empty hands.
2. Clap the beat slowly.
3. March carefully around the room.
4. Freeze when the grown-up says stop.
5. Try loud, quiet, fast, and slow clapping.

Safety: Use clapping or secure age-appropriate shakers. Avoid loose bells and small parts.



Christmas Counting Song

One little present under the tree,

Christmas counting feels just right.

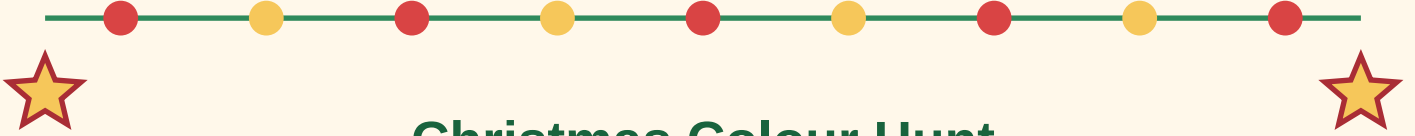
Draw or tick one Christmas picture in each box.

Try: Count slowly with fingers, paper presents, or safe picture cards.

Safety: Use large paper pictures. Avoid small baubles, loose decorations, and items that can break.

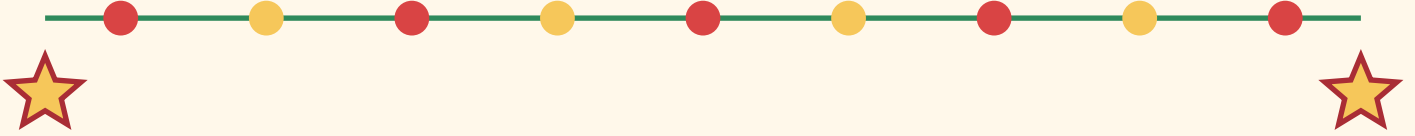
