How to Use These Cards

1. Pick one card

Choose a card that matches your song, animal theme, routine or child's mood.

2. Sing or play music

Use your own tune, a familiar animal song, or gentle background music. No copied lyrics are needed.

3. Add movement

Let children clap, crawl, wiggle, jump, stomp, swim or freeze like the animal.

4. Talk after singing

Ask one simple question: What animal did we sing about? How does it move? What sound does it make?

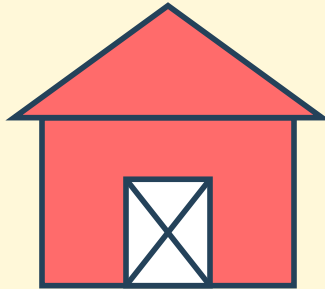
5. Keep it playful

The goal is connection, language, movement and fun. Short sessions work best.

Tip: Laminate or print on card for repeat use.

Farm Animal Sound Card



Sing + Move

Sing about one farm animal at a time. Hold up a picture or toy and let your child copy the sound.

Talk Together

Ask: What animal is this? What sound does it make? Can you move like it?

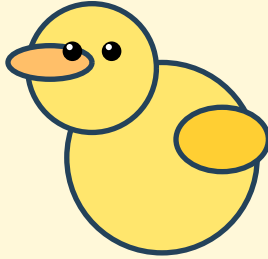
Learning Focus

Five Little Ducks Counting Card



Sing + Move

Use five duck toys, paper ducks or fingers. Move one duck away each round, then bring them all back together.

Talk Together

Count together: 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. Then celebrate when the ducks return.

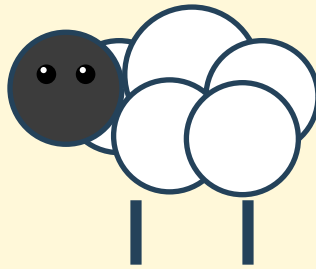
Learning Focus

Counting backwards, memory, story sequence

Soft Sheep Texture Card



Sing + Move

Sing a gentle sheep song while your child touches a soft blanket, cotton wool or fuzzy fabric.

Talk Together

Talk about texture words: soft, fluffy, warm, smooth and cosy.

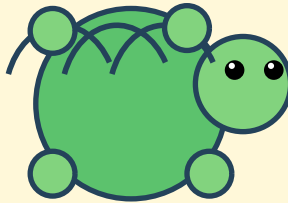
Learning Focus

Sensory language, calm rhythm, turn-taking

Slow Turtle Movement Card



Sing + Move

Pretend to be turtles. Move slowly across the room, stretch your neck, then hide in your shell.

Talk Together

Try slow and fast: Can your turtle move slowly? Can it stop and rest?

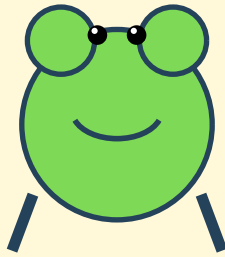

Frog Jump and Count Card



Sing + Move

Make a pretend log with a cushion or box. Let toy frogs or finger frogs jump away one at a time.

Talk Together

Count how many frogs are left. Add a big silly jump at the end.

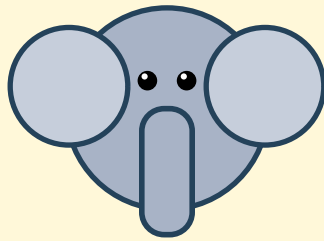

Sing + Move

Let your child choose the next jungle animal and lead the movement.

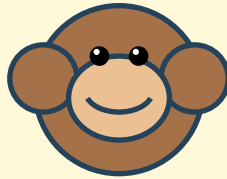

Sing + Move

Freeze between animals. Then ask: Which animal move was your favourite?

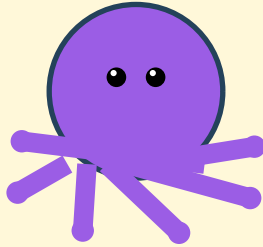

Make ocean sounds softly and move your arms like waves.

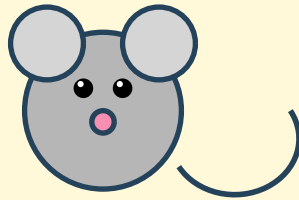

Ask: Where did the mouse go? Is it hiding, running or sleeping?

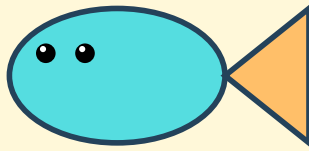

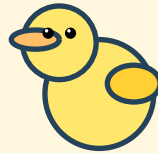
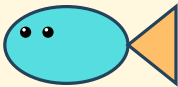
Move Across the Room
