How to Use This Pack

One song, one action, one small learning moment.

Use one page at a time. Keep each activity short, playful, and calm. The goal is not a perfect music lesson. The goal is connection, vocabulary, movement, and noticing the world together.

1

Pick a season

Choose spring, summer, autumn, or winter.

2

Choose one song

Use a familiar tune or make up a simple chant.

3

Add one action

Clap, tap, twirl, hop, shake, point, or draw.

4

Connect to real life

Look outside, touch a leaf, notice rain, or find lights.

5

Celebrate effort

Praise listening, joining in, trying words, and having fun.

Adult note

Always supervise children during crafts, outdoor walks, small objects, homemade instruments, scissors, water play, and online audio or video use. Keep activities age-appropriate and flexible.

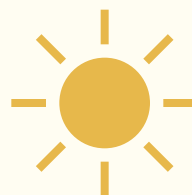
