- 4 Finish any row, column or diagonal to make BINGO!
- 5 Keep the activity playful. There are no wrong answers.

Rhyme Time Bingo

Complete a row, column or diagonal.

Clap to the beat	Sing a rhyme about an animal	Find two rhyming words	Use a hand action
Sing very quietly	Choose the next rhyme	Act like a character	Find a word beginning with S
Draw your favourite rhyme	 FREE SPACE	Sing with a family member	Use a toy or puppet
Make up a new ending	Tap the rhythm	Sing slowly	Find an action word

Mark each completed square with a pencil, sticker or counter.

Rhyme Time Bingo

Complete a row, column or diagonal.

Whisper one line	Stomp to the beat	Choose a silly voice	Point to a picture
Name a character	Find a word beginning with B	Row like a boat	Make a spider action
Find a rhyming pair	 FREE SPACE	Sing outdoors	Use a scarf or ribbon
Add an animal sound	Finish a familiar word	Sing fast, then slow	Tell what happened first

Mark each completed square with a pencil, sticker or counter.

Parent Rhyme-Time Prompts

Use one prompt at a time. Keep it relaxed and responsive.

Pause

Stop before a familiar word and give your child time to respond.

Point

Point to a picture, object or action that matches the rhyme.

Copy

Copy your child's sound, gesture or movement.

Choose

Offer two rhyme choices and let your child decide.

Explain

Briefly explain one unfamiliar word, such as pail or fetch.

Repeat

Repeat favourite rhymes without turning every line into a test.

Create

Invite your child to invent a new character, sound or ending.

Connect

Link the rhyme to books, toys, bath time, walks or bedtime.
